The Altar

The Altar, is the central place of worship where the Paschal Mystery of Christ's suffering, death and resurrection for our salvation is celebrated. The table of the Last Supper, the term altar expresses sacrifice. Traditionally altars included relics of saints, recognising that the celebration of the Eucharistic Liturgy embraces the whole of heaven and earth. Also, during the early Church when Christians were persecuted, Mass was celebrated in the catacombs on the tombs of the martyrs.
