Reflection:

In today's Gospel, John the Baptizer leaves the Gospel stage, exhorting his followers- and us- to "behold the Lamb of God." The word behold connotes more than just to "look"- it implies wonder, attentiveness and awe. John calls us not just to "see" Jesus in our midst, but "behold" his presence: to put aside our fears and stop our constant busyness in order to open our lives to being transformed and re-created in the light of Christ. In this new liturgical year, let us "behold" the Lamb of God among us: to healing, and preaching in our midst; to embrace and be embraced by the love of God that moves and animates this story of his beloved Son's living among us.
